



### Tracking Calls for Service Related to Mental Health

Effective immediately, the Orange County Sheriff's Department will begin collecting data from the Computer-Aided Dispatch (CAD) on mental health related calls for service. This data collection will account for calls, which conclude with a Mental Health disposition. This will help the Department account for the efforts Sheriff's Department personnel dedicate toward people experiencing mental illness.

The CAD call disposition drop-down menu (see screen shot below) has the option of "MTL / Mental." If Field Operations personnel determine the call is related to issues concerning mental health, they will clear the call using the "MTL / Mental" disposition. This determination will be based off the deputy's perception that the subject may be experiencing mental health related issues. Additional dispositions can be selected as appropriate.
